Statutory Requirement to apply for a licence

A person who carries on or wishes to carry on a trust or company service business in Hong Kong is required to apply for a licence under the Anti-Money Laundering and Counter-Terrorist Financing Ordinance (Cap. 615) ("the AMLO"). Any person who carries on a trust or company service business in Hong Kong without a licence commits an offence and is liable on conviction to a fine of up to HK\$100,000 and imprisonment up to 6 months.

What is a trust or company service?

A trust or company service means the provision in Hong Kong by a person, by way of business, of one or more of the following service to other persons

Forming corporations or other legal persons

Acting as, or arranging for another person to act as a director / secretary of a corporation / partner of a partnership or in a similar position in relation to other legal persons

Providing a registered office, business address, correspondence or administrative

Acting as, or arranging for another person to act as

- a trustee of an express trust; or
- a nominee shareholder for a person other than a corporation whose securities are listed on a recognized stock market

Persons exempted from the licensing requirements

- ◆ An authorized institution (as defined in the Banking Ordinance (Cap. 155))
- ◆ A licensed corporation (as defined in the Securities and Futures Ordinance (Cap. 571))
- An accounting professional (i.e. a Certified Public Accountant ("CPA") as defined in the Professional Accountants Ordinance (Cap. 50) or a CPA (practising), a corporate practice or a CPA firm as defined in the Accounting and Financial Reporting Council Ordinance (Cap. 588))
- ◆ A legal professional (i.e. a solicitor or a foreign lawyer as defined in the Legal Practitioners Ordinance (Cap. 159))

- Fees payable
 - Application fee HK\$3,440
 - Additional fee for each person subject to the fit and proper test – HK\$975
- The Registrar of Companies ("the Registrar") may request for additional information and / or documentary evidence whenever necessary
- The Registrar may invite relevant persons to attend interviews to obtain further information

If the application is successful, a licence will be granted

If the Registrar decides not to grant a licence

Applicant will be notified in writing of the decision and the reasons for the decision

TCSP licence

- Valid for 3 years
- Contains the name and business address of licensee
- The Registrar of Companies ("the Registrar") may impose conditions on granting a licence

Comply with

- the requirements of the AMLO and the guidelines issued by the Registrar (including the customer due diligence and record-keeping requirements)
- the licensing conditions imposed by the Registrar

Ongoing obligations of licensee

Revocation / Suspension of licence

Licence may be revoked or suspended if the Registrar is no longer satisfied that the licensee or its ultimate owner / partner / director is fit and proper for carrying on or, to be associated with, a trust or company service business.
